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Re: FORMULA 1 IN SCHOOLS CHALLENGE – LICENSING OF SOFTWARE AND REGISTER FOR THE MANUFACTURING OF CARS AT MANUFACTURING CENTRES

A system for recording the licensing for the academic versions of the Computer Aided Design (CAD) and Computer Aided Manufacturing (CAM) software is introduced. This is required by the different CAD/CAM software suppliers and is part of the legislation to eradicate software piracy.

Schools and institutions are required to complete Annexure A and return it to the F1 in Schools Coordinator by 30 April 2011 on fax: 011 466 1469 or e-mail to: eugene@f1inschools.co.za.

Solid Edge with Synchronous Technology 3 and Solid Works Student Edition 2011/12 is now available and will be distributed to schools and institutions upon receiving their registration form. Registration will take place annually in January.

Each school and institution will have to register every year due to the fact that the software is licensed only for the year of registration. The annual registration of the software is free of charge.

Should a school or institution fail to register their software during January their registration will lapse and they shall be required to re-register with F1 in Schools and pay the required registration fees. In order to sustain the privilege of having an academic license, schools and institutions are required to participate in the F1 in Schools Challenge.

Manufacturing centres must also complete Annexure B and return it to the F1 in Schools Coordinator by 30 April 2011 on fax: 011 466 1469 or e-mail to: eugene@f1inschools.co.za.

A register will also be supplied to the manufacturing centres which they will have to complete for all cars manufactured by them. Teams will receive the original copy from the register and this has to be presented at the registration desk at the race event for which the cars were manufactured. According to the 2011 World Championship rules and regulations teams have to manufacture three identical cars for each race event. For each race event teams have to design a new car and have it manufactured at a registered manufacturing centre.

Teams are also encouraged to visit the F1 in Schools website on a regular basis. Important information is placed on the website and teams must show evidence of their skills with ICT at every race event. Using the website to acquire information is just one way of utilising ICT.

All the Provincial Championships have to be finished by the end of term 3. It is envisaged to have two race events for Gauteng on 28 and 29 April 2011. The National Championship will be held on 22 and 23 July 2011 at Sci-Bono in Newtown Johannesburg. This will give the invited teams enough time to have new designs manufactured and race ready for the latter mentioned championship. What needs to be kept in mind is that the International Championships takes place from 17 to 26 September 2011 in Malaysia. Teams should therefore be ready for their Provincial Championships in August or at the latest the first week in September.

The National Championship will take place in Gauteng in February/March 2010. An exact date will be communicated once the venue has been finalized.
